



NCAA® 4Kay Run *Frequently Asked Questions*

What is the date of the event?

The race will be held Saturday, April 2, 2016.

When does the race start?

The 5K will begin at 8 a.m.

When and where is Packet Pick-Up?

Friday, April 1, 9 a.m. – 8 p.m. at the WBCA registration area inside the Indiana Convention Center
Saturday, April 2, 6:30 a.m. – 7:30 a.m. at Bankers Life Fieldhouse

**5K Participants should pick up their packet by 7:30 a.m. on race day*

We recommend picking your packet up on Friday to avoid race morning delays. When picking up your packet, please bring one form of picture identification.

What is the distance?

We offer a 5K, 3.1 miles long.

What is the Kay Yow Cancer Fund?

The Kay Yow Cancer Fund was officially founded on December 3, 2007, from the vision of the organization's namesake Kay Yow, former North Carolina State University head women's basketball coach.

Kay Yow was first diagnosed with breast cancer in 1987, and passed away on January 24, 2009, after facing her third bout with the disease. Before her death, she joined forces with the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) and The V Foundation for Cancer Research to form the Kay Yow Cancer Fund, a 501 (c)(3) charitable organization committed to being a part of finding an answer in the fight against women's cancers through raising money for scientific research, assisting the underserved and unifying people for a common cause.

Since 2007, the Kay Yow Cancer Fund has awarded over \$3.9 million in scientific research grants and related programs, with future research projects currently under review. To learn more about the Kay Yow Cancer Fund or to donate, please visit www.KayYow.com.

What is the 4Kay event?

The 4Kay event is one of many events that are part of the 2016 NCAA Women's Final Four. The event is held annually in the host city for the NCAA Women's Final Four. The inaugural 4Kay event was held in Tampa at the 2008 NCAA Women's Final Four.

How can I register?

Online registration closes April 1. Race day registration will be available provided the events are not sold out.

How much does it cost to register for the 5K?

Before 12/31/15 - \$20

Between 01/01/16 - 04/01/16 - \$25

Race Day - \$30

What does my registration fee go towards?

Registration fees go to the Kay Yow Cancer Fund to help find an answer in the fight against women's cancers.

Are there awards or prizes?

Prizes will be awarded to the top three male and female finishers.

How do I get a race shirt?

The first 1,000 registered participants will receive a 4Kay Run race shirt.

When should I get to the Start Line?

Participants should plan to be in the Start Line area by 7:45 a.m.

Where is the Start Line?

The race will begin at the Ober Lot on S. Pennsylvania Street next to Bankers Life Fieldhouse.

Will the 4Kay Run be cancelled for inclement weather?

The 4Kay Run will not be cancelled for inclement weather unless the weather is such that it will threaten the safety of the participants and attendees.

Where can I park?

Metered street parking will be available on the streets surrounding Bankers Life Fieldhouse as well as the [Circle Center Mall garages](#) for \$4 if parking for 3-4 hours. Please be aware that event road closures and race morning traffic will add to congestion and likely increase your time to park. We suggest arriving early and planning for delays.

Can someone else pick up my packet?

If you have completed your waiver, yes, someone else can pick up your packet. That person must show a copy of their own photo ID and fill out a short form. If you have not completed your waiver, you must pick up your own packet.

How do I complete my waiver?

If you registered yourself online, you have already completed your waiver. If you were registered by someone else online (such as a friend or family member), you are registered, but must still complete your waiver. To complete your waiver online [click here](#).

How do I know if I have completed my waiver?

What is the course like?

The race will start and finish in front of Bankers Life Fieldhouse, and will run the streets of downtown passing some of Indianapolis' most iconic landmarks over the course of 3.1 miles (5K distance). Runners will start by heading north on Pennsylvania, then will turn onto 9th at the Central Library before heading back south on Meridian where runners will head towards the famed Soldiers and Sailors monument on Monument Circle. Runners will then head west on Washington toward West Street where the course heads south to Maryland. Runners will pass the home of Tourney Town at the Indianapolis Convention Center before turning south on Capitol and hitting the home stretch along Georgia Street. Participants should line up according to their pace with the fastest runners lining up near the front. Participants may walk, but should not walk in groups of more than three wide as to not impede the paths of others. IMPD and course marshal volunteers will help control traffic along the route, but participants should stay within the designated running lanes of the course.

Can I walk the course?

Absolutely! Walkers are more than welcome to participate. We ask that walkers line up behind other runners at the start of the event. Walkers should not walk in groups of more than three wide as to not impede the paths of others.

Can I use a jogging/walking stroller?

Jogging/Walking strollers are permitted. However, these participants must line up behind all other participants. Bicycles, scooters, roller blades, and other forms of wheeled motorization are prohibited.

Can I bike/roller blade/scooter the course?

Bicycles, scooters, roller blades, and other forms of wheeled motorization are not permitted. Walking/jogging strollers are permitted provided the participant begins behind all other participants.

Can I run/walk with my pet?

Pets are not allowed to run/walk with participants. Service animals are permitted.

Where can my family/friends watch the race?

Spectators will be able to view their participant from several areas throughout the course as well

at the Finish Line area.

Do I need my email confirmation?

Occasionally confirmation emails go into your spam or junk folder. If you are unsure if you are registered, please email our race managers at Tuxedo Brothers: tuxbro@indy.rr.com. Email confirmations are NOT needed for packet pickup.

How can I confirm if I am registered?

Do you offer refunds or deferrals?

There are no refunds or deferrals. The no-refund policy includes requests made due to injury, surgery, pregnancy, personal circumstances, date conflicts and professional commitments.

Can I transfer my registration to someone else?

Participants may not transfer their registration to someone else.

What is Tourney Town presented by Capital One?

Stay after the race to experience Tourney Town! This free event is the epicenter for all Women's Final Four fan and community activities. Visitors will enjoy entertainment, concerts, food, licensed merchandise, autograph sessions, basketball clinics, exhibits, games, and interactive displays. Tourney Town will be open to the public Saturday April 2 (8:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.), Sunday April 3 (11 a.m. – 6:30 p.m.), and Tuesday April 5 (4:00 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.).
