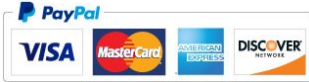

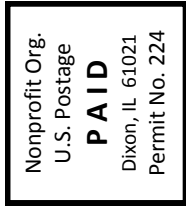

- Making Sense of the World
- Communication
- Safety
- Self-Esteem
- Pursuing Interests
- Self-Regulation
- Independence
- Social Relationships
- Self-Advocacy
- Earning a Living

- Name at least two ways of fostering independence in ASD students/children.
