## Registration and Sign-up Rules

- Registration will open 1 month prior to tournament date and will close the day before the tournament
- The cost will be $\$ 120$ per team, with a maximum of 4 players on each team, and a maximum of 16 teams
- Liability waivers and tournament fee must be submitted before the first game
- Tournament directors will be responsible for collections and check-in
- Sign-in and registration table will be placed at the north end of the sprint lanes next to the track desk, away from fitness center members
- All registered participants will receive a tournament $t$-shirt for participating. Any extra shirts will be raffled to spectators.


## Tournament Layout

- 16 teams will be divided into 4 pools of 4 teams. In the event of less than 16 teams signing up, pools will be divided evenly among the number of teams participating.
- Games will start every 15 minutes, with the first two games starting at 10 am.
- Each team will play $\mathbf{3}$ games within their pool, playing each team once.
- After pool play is completed, the teams will be seeded into a single-elimination tournament based on the team's record. If a tie should occur, the team that scored the most points will be the higher seed. If a tie still exists, the number of points allowed will be used to determine the seeds.
- Every team will be guaranteed at least one game in the single elimination tournament, totaling 4 guaranteed games for each team.


## Scoring and Rules

- Each game will be played on a 12 minute running clock, except for the championship game that will be a 15 minute running clock. The team with the most points at the end of the time limit will be the winner.
- One clock will be used as the timer for both games occurring on the court.
- Score will be kept by scorekeepers at the timer/scoring table.
- In the event of a tie at the end of 12 minutes, 1 minute will be added to the clock as overtime.
- If the game is still tied after overtime, a shootout will occur.
- 1 point will be awarded for each basket made inside the regulation college three-point line, and 2 points will be awarded for each basket made beyond the regulation college three-point line.
- Fouls called by the referee will result in possession being retained by the fouled team.
- After a team commits 5 fouls, each additional foul will result in 1 point being awarded to the fouled team, and possession will still be retained by the fouled team.
- One warning will be administered for misconduct toward the refs or any other tournament official.
- Zero tolerance will be had for any physical altercations involving tournament participants and/or spectators. Guilty parties will be ejected from the game and removed from the premises at the discretion of the tournament officials and referees.

First Place Team:

Contests: $\$ 5$ each or $\$ 10$ for all 3
3-point Contest

- Friday (Day before event) will be the first round of the 3pt contest.
- Each participant will have 1 minute to shoot 18 shots from three different stations.
- The last ball will be worth 2 points.
- 4 winners will advance
- Saturday after pool play will be the semi-final and final rounds of the 3pt contest.
- Prize to be given:

Skills Challenge:

- Friday (Day before event) will be the first round of the Skill Challenge.
- Timed obstacle course consisting of dribbling, passing and shooting.
- Player with the fastest time wins.
- Two players go head to head.
- Course consist of :
- Starting from the baseline, dribbling full court through cones to make a pass in donut
- Grab another ball to dribble back down the court to make a lay up
- Grab another ball to dribble down the court and finish by hitting at 3 pointer.
